- The finale on May 26th gives us a taste of True North: Canadian Cooking from Coast to Coast with Derek Dammann and Chris Johns.

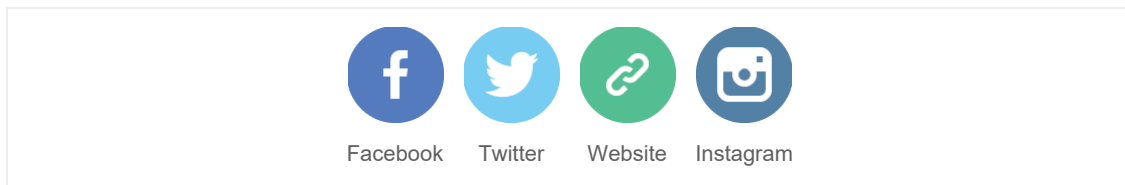
